Workshop Description:



This workshop will focus on how to make your colors sing by understanding color combinations and the importance of a "dirty" color, by using thoughtful underpainting to build layers, and by understanding the nuances of the colors you see to allow you to "push" your colors for richness. The instructor will demonstate different color palette setups, and encourage exploring change when you are in a rut.

The instructor will also teach the importance of shadows for rich value contrasts and help you use composition and directional patterns to bring the viewer into your painting.

You are encouraged to bring a few images of your choice from which to develop a painting, either on your laptop or printed on paper. Print them in color and large enough to work from. Or, the instructor will provide images from which you may work.

Lori Keith Robinson Biography:

Award-winning artist Lori Keith Robinson has made Savannah, Georgia her home for over 25 years. She has won numerous "Best of Shows" in national and local plein air events. She was co-owner of the well-known Chroma Gallery, which received "Best Gallery" for over 10 years from Savannah Magazine's Best Of Savannah. Her work is highly prized and hangs in the collections of former CEO of General Dynamics, Nicholus Chabraja, Georgia Ports Authority, Savannah Economic Development Authority, Baptist Medical Center South, Palmetto Bluff, Memorial Health, and Georgia Southern University, along with many homes across the nation.

She teaches plein air workshops around the southeast, including the Jepson Museum's Plein Air in Bonaventure. She has judged and demonstrated for many local competition events. Lori received her Bachelor of Arts, *Summa Cum Laude* from Pembroke State University in painting and pursued post gratuate studies from Savannah College of Art and Design. Lori continued her education with workshops from national plein air artists: Kevin MacPherson, Camille Przewodek, Susan Sarback and Ken Auster.
